

Indian Society of Anaesthesiologists (ISA National) Advisory and Position Statement regarding COVID-19

#### **PREAMBLE**

Indian Society of Anaesthesiologists issues the following advisory and position statement to ensure safety of patients and the anaesthesiologists during the "Corona Virus Disease 2019" (COVID[19) in India.

Infection Prevention and Control policies have to be followed religiously. Human to human transmission occurs by droplet, contact and fomites and average incubation period is 2[10 days. The mortality rate is 2[3% but infectivity rate is very high, leading to increased morbidity and workload on health care. The mortality is high in immuno[compromised and elderly patients.

Anaesthesiologist interaction with patients with COVID[19 can occur in Accident and Emergency Department/Trauma Centre for emergency airway management; Critical Care/Intensive Care Units; Pre[Anaesthetic Check Up (PAC) Clinics and Pain Clinics; Perioperative Anaesthesia Care; and Anaesthesia at remote locations: endoscopy, ECT, Radiology (MRI) etc., The anaesthesiologists have to take care of the patients as well as themselves.

As the understanding of COVID[19 is being updated regularly and so are the guidelines, this ISA advisory and position statement is also subject to change and updation.

#### **ISA POSITION STATEMENT**

 There can be a sudden surge of patients and health care demands. The hospital resources can get exhausted quickly and medical personnel can be under tremendous work stress, both clinical and psychological. Hence, existing resources have to be preserved and additional generated immediately. In coming days, a large number of patients may suddenly require oxygen therapy, tracheal intubation and ventilatory support. The facilities, devices and equipments for the same should be updated with repairs, services, replacements and fresh purchases as per the demand assessment.

- There should be adequate oxygen delivery devices, adequate oxygen reserve and multiple tracheal intubation teams have to be designated. A pool of anaesthesiologists has to be created at city branch level so that anaesthesiologists can be immediately shifted to the area of increased demand.
- Elective and semi mergency surgeries should be deferred till the outbreak of COVID 19 is contained. Only emergency surgeries should be undertaken.
  - Non urgent and non time sensitive consultations; surgical, interventional and diagnostic procedures should be rescheduled to a later date when the COVID transmission is contained in the community. The decision for urgent and time sensitive procedures (cancer surgeries) should be taken as a team, based on the available resources and patient's clinical condition. This will conserve manpower, personal protective equipment and critical care beds.
- 4. Transmission of COVID

  19 can also occur from the anaesthesia workplace. Frequent hand washing by the anaesthesiologists is essential. Designated operating rooms having a dedicated anaesthesia machine and cart for high infection risk situations has to be done.
- If need arises, anaesthesia machine ventilators in the operation theatres will be used as

However, all the 30,000 plus anaesthesiologists are anguished on reading the following statements in Times of India, which states that during Bennet University's Global Online Conference on COVID Fallout & Future held on 09-04-2020 you have expressed that "We must not over-professionalize the systemWe don't always need a qualified MBBS to give us an anesthesia or read scans."

The medical discipline of Anaesthesiology requires attaining thorough knowledge and high level of skills for rendering a patient reversibly unconscious for surgical procedures, including cardiac surgery, neurosurgery, pediatric surgery, obstetric surgery and the like. Also the anesthesiologists are well trained & qualified and are giving exemplary service in critical /intensive care, acute & chronic pain management and resuscitation. Even the Hon'ble Supreme Court has ruled that anaesthesia can be administered only by qualified anaesthesiologists (MD, DA or DNBE).

## ISA ADVISORY AND POSITION STATEMENT (II) REGARDING COVID-19 PANDEMIC

Dear ISAians,

**Greetings from ISA National Head Quarters!** 

We all are in the midst of COVID-19 pandemic. Indian Society of Anaesthesiologists National appreciates, acknowledges and places on record the efforts by its members across the nation.

Indian Society of Anaesthesiologists National issues the following ISA Advisory and Position Statement (II) arising out of COVID-19 pandemic:

#### 1. Use of PPE, Masks and Face Shields by Anaesthesiologists

- ñ ISA advises all its members to wear N 95 mask and face shield along with cap, gloves and surgical gown during all surgical procedures till further notice.
- ñ Please follow Government instructions for the indications of use of PPE. (Attached)
- ñ Administration of anaesthesia to confirmed COVID 19 patients is to be done in dedicated COVID OT in designated COVID Hospitals only. The advisory on conduct of anaesthesia in such patients has been already published on 23 March 2020. (Copy attached for ready reference)

#### 2. Availability of PPE, Masks and Face Shields for Anaesthesiologists

- ñ The respective ISA State and City Branch President and Secretary are requested to identify vendors near to their place and circulate the details of the same in social media groups/ sms and the like to all the members of the city.
- ñ Please procure standard N 95 / FFP3 masks only.





Corona virus disease 2019 (COVID-19) caused by SARS-CoV-2 has spread worldwide and has affected millions of people. Patients with COVID-19 may have to undergo elective or emergency surgical procedures under local or general anaesthesia. It is advisable to postpone elective surgeries in such patients, even if they are asymptomatic, till the time they test negative for this virus. There are reports of higher incidence of morbidity and mortality in COVID infected patients following surgery. However, emergent surgeries would be required to be carried out, like cesarean sections, acute abdominal conditions, pediatric and neonatal emergencies, trauma, tracheostomies in Intensive Care Unit (ICU) and the like. Such emergency surgical procedures necessitate setting up of dedicated COVID OPERATION THEATRES (COVID OT).

#### **SETTING UP COVID OT**

#### 1. Name of Operation Theatre

- Dedicated Operation
   Theatres are to be used for all confirmed or suspected
   COVID-19 infected patients
- These operation theatres should be labeled as "COVID-19 Operation Theatre (COVID OT)"
- Large clear bill boards and signage in local language and/or english, visible from a distance, should be placed outside such OTs

#### . Number of Operation Theatres

- Ideally, there should be 2 COVID OTs:
  - One for obstetrical surgical procedures
  - Second for general surgery/orthopaedics/other surgical procedures for all age groups

#### 3. Location

- The operation theatres should be located in the dedicated COVID Block/Centre
- There should not be any adjoining inhabited buildings within 20 meters
- COVID OTs should be preferably located near to COVID ICU, High Dependency Unit (HDU), Isolation ward and Emergency ward

#### 4. Changing Room

 There should be separate changing rooms for male and female heath care workers with attached toilet and shower facilities

#### **ABSTRACT**

Management of the recent outbreak of the novel coronavirus disease (COVID-19) caused by the severe acute respiratory syndrome coronavirus 2(SARS-CoV-2) remains challenging. The challenges are not only limited to its preventive strategies, but also extend to curative treatment, and are amplified during the management of critically ill patients with COVID-19. Older persons with comorbidities like diabetes mellitus, cardiac diseases, hepatic impairment, renal disorders and respiratory pathologies or immune impairing conditions are more vulnerable and have a higher mortality from COVID-19. Earlier, the Indian Resuscitation Council (IRC) had proposed the Comprehensive Cardiopulmonary Life Support (CCLS) for management of cardiac arrest victims in the hospital setting. However, in patients with COVID-19, the guidelines need to be modified, due to various concerns like differing etiology of cardiac arrest, virulence of the virus, risk of its transmission to rescuers, and the need to avoid or minimize aerosolization from the patient due to various interventions. There is limited evidence in these patients, as the SARS-CoV-2 is a novel infection and not much literature is available with high-level evidence related to CPR in patients of COVID-19. These suggested guidelines are a continuum of CCLS guidelines by IRC with an emphasis on the various challenges and concerns being faced during the resuscitative management of COVID-19 patients with cardiopulmonary arrest.





Indian Society of Anaesthesiologists (ISA), the largest body of Anaesthesiologists in India with more than 30,000 members, represents clinical, academic and social issues pertaining to anaesthesiologists in India. The anaesthesiologists are working dedicatedly in the critical care of COVID patients in intensive care units in this pandemic. They are in CORE TEAM A.

Taking cognizance of the reports appearing in social media, it is shocking and disheartening to note that a female anaesthesiologist working in Government Doon Medical College, Dehradun, Uttarakhand and her family have been caged behind a 7 feet tall barricade. The family includes a 75 years old lady, diabetic, hypothyroid and with other medical disorders; and a 3 year old child. The doctor tested COVID positive while on duty and now is COVID negative. It is very shocking, sad and unwarranted step. Nowhere in the country containment zones are made in such a way. The doctor and her family had suffered severe psychological trauma due to this inhuman attitude. Is this the reward to doctors who risk their lives and do selfless services? This step has a demoralizing effect on the medical fraternity and there is a sense of deep anguish amongst anaesthesiologists across the country.

You are requested to intervene and instruct to get the cage removed immediately without any further delay.
